# HIGHLIGHTS OF THE INAUGURAL SESSION

The Electronics and Computer Software Export Promotion Council (ESC) organised the 24th edition of its flagship event – INDIASOFT 2024 during 17th-19th January 2024 at New Delhi. The event was gracioused by the presence of Mr. Piyush Goyal, Hon'ble Minister of Commerce and Industry and Minister of Consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution and Textiles, Mr. Arjun Meghwal, Hon'ble Minister of State for Law and Justice (Independent Charge) and Ms. Meenakshi Lekhi, Hon'ble Minister of State for External Affairs, Government of India. Deputy Minister of Communications, Cuba Eng. Wilfredo Gonzalez Vidal was the Guest of Honour.





# **Inaugural address**

In his opening remarks, Mr. Gurmeet Singh, Executive Director at ESC, reflected on the evolution of INDIASOFT since 2001, noting its increasing opportunities and the rise in business transactions with each edition. He emphasized that INDIASOFT 2024 wasn't just a gathering of industry leaders and stakeholders but a dynamic showcase of technology's transformative potential. In an age defined by rapid digitization, he underscored the crucial role of collaboration and knowledge sharing, portraying the event as a crucible of ideas shaping the IT landscape's future.

# Address by the VIPs and guests

During the Inaugural session, Union Minister of State for Law and Justice, (Independent Charge), Mr. Arjun Ram Meghwal said that *India had entered into an exciting stage of information technology, wherein tools like Artificial Intelligence (AI), Robotics, Blockchain etc. were transforming India's development agenda.* 

Further, he highlighted that every segment of the Indian economy was moving towards digitization in all avenues including the domain of legal affairs, transforming the country into a digital behemoth; he added that the process would continue unabated and would transform boundaries into opportunities.



The Hon'ble Minister also said, "..forums like INDIASOFT should not only pave the way for networking among IT professionals and entrepreneurs, but pool their minds to strategize how IT technology should lead to more inclusive growth."







Eng. Gonzalez Vidal Wilfredo, First Vice Minister of Communications Ministry of Communications, Cuba invited Indian IT companies to invest in his country and to be a partner in the fast emerging investment opportunities both in the software and hardware segments. He also referred to the ICT show being held in Cuba in March this year and invited India to participate in large numbers.

ELCIA Cluster is a Common Facility Centre (CFC) that supports MSME units by making available various facilities



needed for their operations. ESDC is imparting skills to enhance employability of manpower needed by companies in the tech space. ELCIA Trust carries out Community Services in and around Electronics City.


